Units are shown at brigade level. Icons with small flags are units played-out, demoralized, or out of ammunition. Only pertinent artillery positions are shown. In all other cases, batteries are considered to be imbedded with the infantry or cavalry units they are supporting.

JOHN BEATTY'S PREDICAMENT

When Beatty first arrived on the army's far left, he positioned his brigade on Baird's left astride La Fayette Road facing north, as the presumed position. A staffer from Thomas then told Beatty he was to cover the area from Baird's left all the way to John McDonald's house at the crossroads (location of the present Visitor Center). Beatty complied as best he could, but felt that his brigade was covering ground worthy of a division.
